In accordance with article 4 and 5 of the temporary Statute of the International Public College of Business in Mitrovica, the Law on Higher Education of the Republic of Kosovo 04L/37, and the Regulation no. 987, date: 10/10/2024 for the award of the scholarships for students at the Public International Business College Mitrovica, the IBCM College announces:

Announcement for Awarding Scholarships for students at the IBCM College for academic year 2025/26

Based on the Regulation no. 987, date: 10/10/2024 for the award of the scholarships for students at the Public International Business College Mitrovica, the IBCM College is opening the call for awarding the following types of scholarships:

1. Merit-based scholarships;
2. Affirmative scholarships for communities;
3. Scholarships to subsidize the accommodation of students living at long distances from IBCM College;
4. "Dardana Petershoni" scholarships for students for coming from families with lower socio-economic conditions.

All students of Bachelor and Master level studies are eligible to apply, who meet the criteria and conditions of the call.

I. Merit Based scholarship

1. For the merit-based scholarship, the following criteria apply:
 - 1.1. Be regular students at IBCM College;
 - 1.2. To be in the second year of studies or higher;
 - 1.3. Have not a repeated year of studies;
 - 1.4. To have passed all the exams of the previous years by the exam term of September 2025;
 - 1.5. Have at least 70% attendance in lectures in both semesters;

- 1.6. Have an average grade, at least:
 - a. 10.0 (according to the IBCM grading system) for students pursuing studies in the Bachelor's program in Public Administration and Welfare, in the Bachelor's in International Sales and Management, and in the Master's program in International Management and Leadership;
 - b. 8.5 (according to the IBCM grading system) for students pursuing their studies in the Bachelor's program in applied IT, and in the Bachelor's in Environmental and Agricultural Management;
2. To apply for a merit scholarship, students must submit the following documents:
 - 2.1. The application form (downloaded from the IBCM website or physically obtained from the student service), completed and signed;
 - 2.3. Grade certificate (obtained from the student service);
 - 2.4. A letter from the respective Faculty about the student's regular status;
 - 2.5. Confirmation sheet from the respective Faculty on the attendance of lectures in the two semesters of the academic year 2024/25;
 - 2.6. The declaration under oath (downloaded from the IBCM website or physically obtained from student services), completed and signed;

II. Affirmative scholarships for communities

1. The right to application for the affirmative scholarships for communities have all students of Bachelor and Master studies at IBCM College, who come from non-majority communities in Kosovo.
2. All students of the IBCM College at the Bachelor and Master level, who meet the following conditions and criteria, have the right to apply for the affirmative scholarship for communities.
3. The criteria for the allocation of affirmative scholarships are as follows:
 - 3.1. Be from non-Albanian and non-Serbian communities in Kosovo;
 - 3.2. Be regular students at IBCM College;
 - 3.3. Have registered the academic year 2024/25;
 - 3.4. Have at least 70% lecture attendance for the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded;
4. To apply for an affirmative scholarship for communities, students must submit the following documents:
 - 4.1. Application form, completed and signed (downloaded from the website, or received at the student service);
 - 4.2. A letter from the Faculty about the student's regular status;

- 4.3. Confirmation letter from the Faculty on the attendance of lectures (demonstrated in percentage).
 - 4.4. Evidence of the student's ethnicity;
 - 4.5. Declaration under oath, completed and signed (downloaded from the website, or received at the student service).
5. 1st semester students are eligible to apply, reporting the attendance for the weeks that the lecture started in the academic year 2025/26.

III. Scholarships to subsidize the accommodation of students living at long distances from IBCM College

1. The right to application for the scholarships for subsidizing accommodation have all students of Bachelor's studies at IBCM College, who come from remote municipalities of Kosovo, from where daily travel to attend lectures is impractical.
2. All students of the IBCM College at the Bachelor level who meet the following conditions and criteria are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
3. The criteria for allocating scholarships to subsidize accommodation are as follows:
 - 3.1. Be from settlements (permanent living address) with a distance of minimum 25 kilometers from IBCM College;
 - 3.2. Be regular students at IBCM College;
 - 3.3. Have registered the relevant academic year 2025/26;
 - 3.4. Have at least 70% lecture attendance for the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded;
 - 3.5. Have an average grade of at least seven (7) according to the IBCM grading system in the following year of study.
4. To apply for this scholarship, students must submit the following documents:
 - 4.1. Application form, completed and signed;
 - 4.2. Grade certificate (obtained from the student service);
 - 4.3. Proof of address in permanent residence;
 - 4.4. A letter from the Faculty about the student's regular status;
 - 4.5. Confirmation letter from the Faculty on the attendance of lectures (demonstrated in percentage).
 - 4.6. Declaration under oath, completed and signed.
5. 1st semester students are eligible to apply, reporting the attendance for the weeks that the lecture started in the academic year 2025/26.
6. 1st semester students are excluded from points 3.5 and 4.2 under this type of scholarship.

IV. "Dardana Petershoni" scholarship for students with lower socio-economic conditions

1. Scholarships for students with lower socio-economic conditions are allocated to students of Bachelor's and Master's studies at IBCM College, who come from families with lower socio-economic conditions.
2. The right to apply for this scholarship is available to all students of IBCM College at the Bachelor's and Master's level, who meet the conditions and criteria listed below.
3. The criteria for awarding these scholarships are as follows:
 - 3.1. To come from families with lower socio-economic conditions;
 - 3.2. Be regular students at IBCM College;
 - 3.3. Have registered the relevant academic year for which the scholarship is awarded;
 - 3.4. Have at least 70% lecture attendance for the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded (for 1st year students are applicable the lecture attendance during the month of October);
 - 3.5. Have an average grade of at least seven (7) according to the IBCM grading system (not applicable for 1st semester students).
4. To apply for this scholarship, students must submit the following documents:
 - 4.1. Application form (downloaded from the IBCM website or physically obtained from the student service), completed and signed;
 - 4.2. Grade certificate (obtained from the student service);
 - 4.3. Proof of the socio-economic status of the family, in any of the cases listed below:
 - 4.3.1. families that are on social assistance (evidence obtained from center for social work);
 - 4.3.2. families that have a self-supporting parent with a monthly income at / below the minimum wage determined by the Government of Kosovo (work contract, or tax administration evidence, or any other relevant evidence);
 - 4.3.3. families that do not have any members employed at work regular (evidence from pension system, or tax administration evidence, or any other relevant evidence).
 - 4.4. Certification from the Faculty about the student's regular status;
 - 4.5. Confirmation letter from the Faculty on the continuity of lectures in the two semesters of the academic year for which the scholarship is announced.
 - 4.6. Declaration under oath (downloaded from the IBCM website or physically obtained from student services), completed and signed;
5. 1st semester students are eligible to apply, reporting the attendance for the weeks that the lecture started in the academic year 2025/26.



6. 1st semester students are excluded from points 3.5 and 4.2 under this type of scholarship.

V. Application deadline and submission of documents

1. The application period is from 04/11/2025 to 14/11/2025.
2. The submission of documents is made to the student service at the IBCM College.
3. Please make sure you submit all required documents as required per criteria of this call.
4. Note that students can apply for only one type of scholarships, with the exception that applications can be made for both accommodation subsidy and for affirmative scholarships for communities.

IV. Announcement of results and complains

1. The announcement of the results from applications for this call will be done until 18th November 2025.
2. Students applying for the scholarship schemes have the right file an appeal, against the decision of the IBCM College for awarding scholarships, to the IBCM Appeals Committee, within 5 days from the announcement of the scholarship decision.
